



Impossible Assignments:

- **If we're going to accomplish the impossible with God, we cannot focus on our smallness.**
- Don't be deceived by size. Don't focus on the smallness of our beginnings, or the size of your capabilities. (Moses; the 11; the Summit)




Impossible Assignments:

- **If we're going to accomplish the impossible with God, we cannot focus on the size of the task. (tiny seed – garden tree; small leaven – 60lbs of flour) (Moses; 11; today)**
- If we look at how small we are, how small our resources and capabilities are, or if we look at how large our assignment is, we will be overwhelmed, and limited to the possible.




Impossible Assignments:

- **If we're going to accomplish the impossible with God, we must focus on the size of our King & the certainty of His Kingdom.**
- The outcome is not in doubt. There is no question about the massive influence of the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom message is pregnant with impossibilities. (the seed; the leaven; Moses; the 11) The mystery is why? Why is the outcome certain? Why does the Kingdom have disproportional impact?



Impossible Assignments:

- The future of the Kingdom is sure, because of the presence of the King. When the King is present, His Kingdom comes. Wherever the King is, His Kingdom comes. It is His presence that affects change.

- Moses knew what distinguished the Israelites was God's presence. (Exodus 20; Ex 33)
- The 11 knew their success was due to the presence of the King. (Matthew 28:16-20) (1st 6 months)
